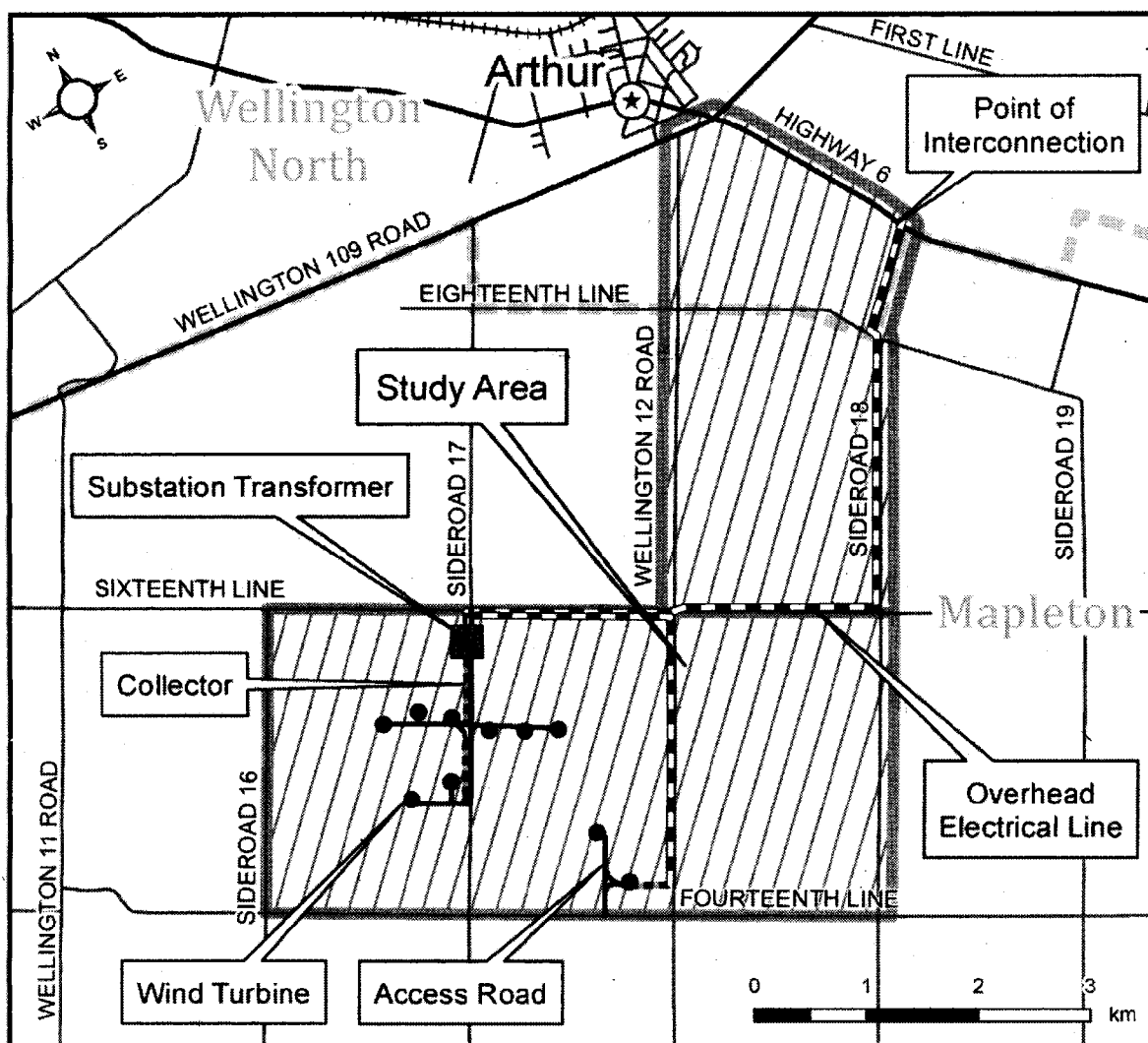

Project Description:

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which this project is to be engaged in, is a Class 4 Wind Facility. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of 22.92-megawatts. The project location is described in the map below.

The Draft Project Description Report titled *Conestogo Wind Energy Centre Draft Project Description Report* describes the project as a single Class 4 Wind Facility consisting of nine 2.3-megawatt wind turbines and one 2.22-megawatt turbine with ancillary facilities including step-up transformers, transformer substation, electrical collector systems, turbine access roads, meteorological tower and construction staging areas for a maximum nameplate capacity of 22.92-megawatts in the area of Arthur, Ontario that will be used to convert the wind energy into electricity.

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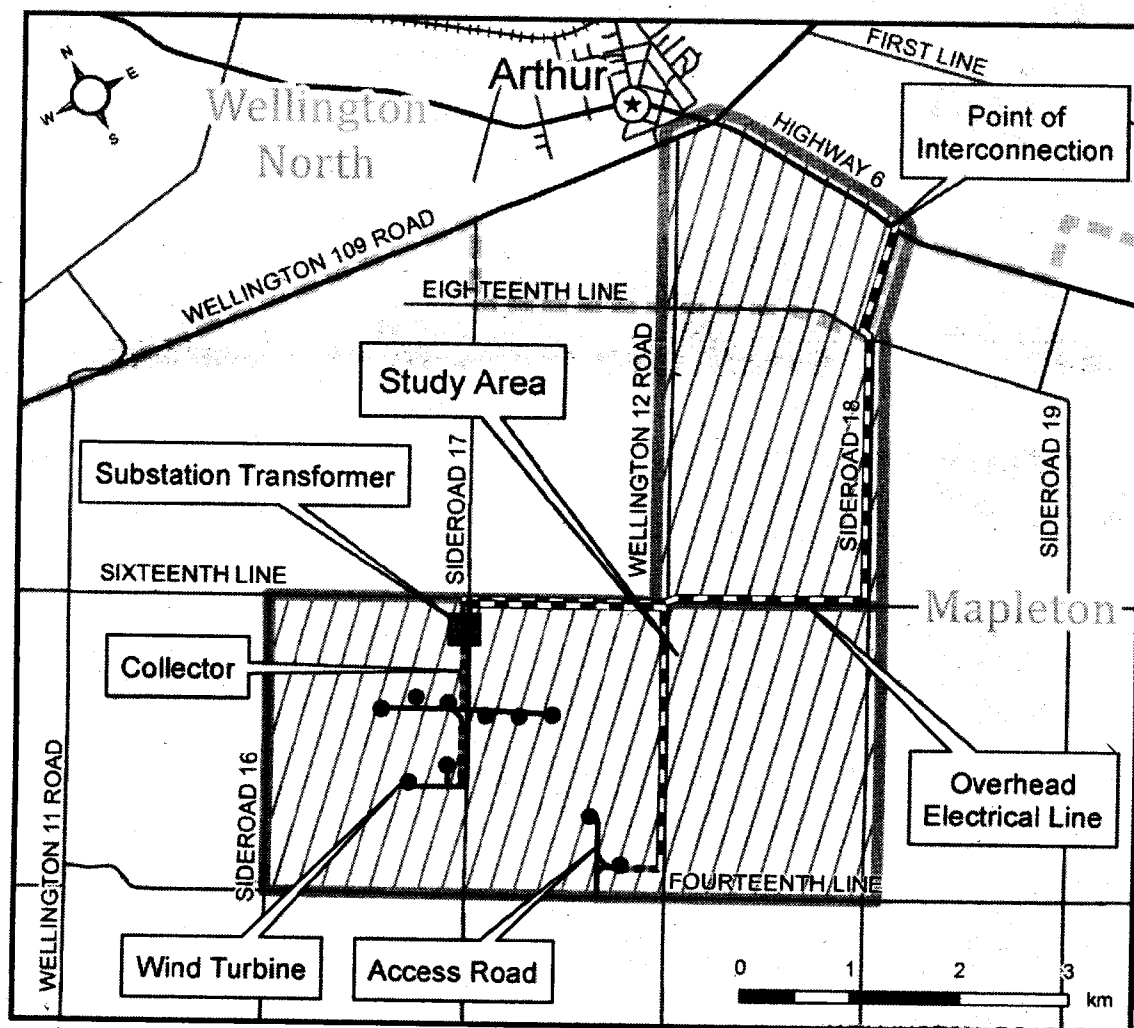

Why is Southwestern Ontario a great choice for wind energy?

Wind developers favour Southwestern Ontario for two main reasons:

1. strong and consistent wind levels, particularly around the Great Lakes
2. available and adjacent electricity transmission

Why Wellington County?

- » wind speeds are favourable for wind energy generation
- » wind data has been collected in Project Study Area since 2006 measuring wind speeds at 40 metre, 50 metre and 60 metre heights
- » region is well serviced by existing distribution lines that have available capacity
- » existing transmission lines can transport electricity to the surrounding communities and larger urban centres

Ontario's Renewable Energy Approval Process

- » Renewable Energy Approval (REA) process, outlined in Ontario Regulation 359/09, is required for renewable energy projects under Ontario's Green Energy Act
- » NextEra Energy Canada will submit a Renewable Energy Approval application to the Ontario Ministry of the Environment (MOE) for this project
- » MOE will assess application for completeness and decide whether to issue approval
- » other agencies, including the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR), the Ministry of Transportation (MTO), the Ministry of Tourism and Culture (MTC) and Grand River Conservation Authority also review reports for approval
- » once submitted, MOE will post the application on website for 30 days for public comments

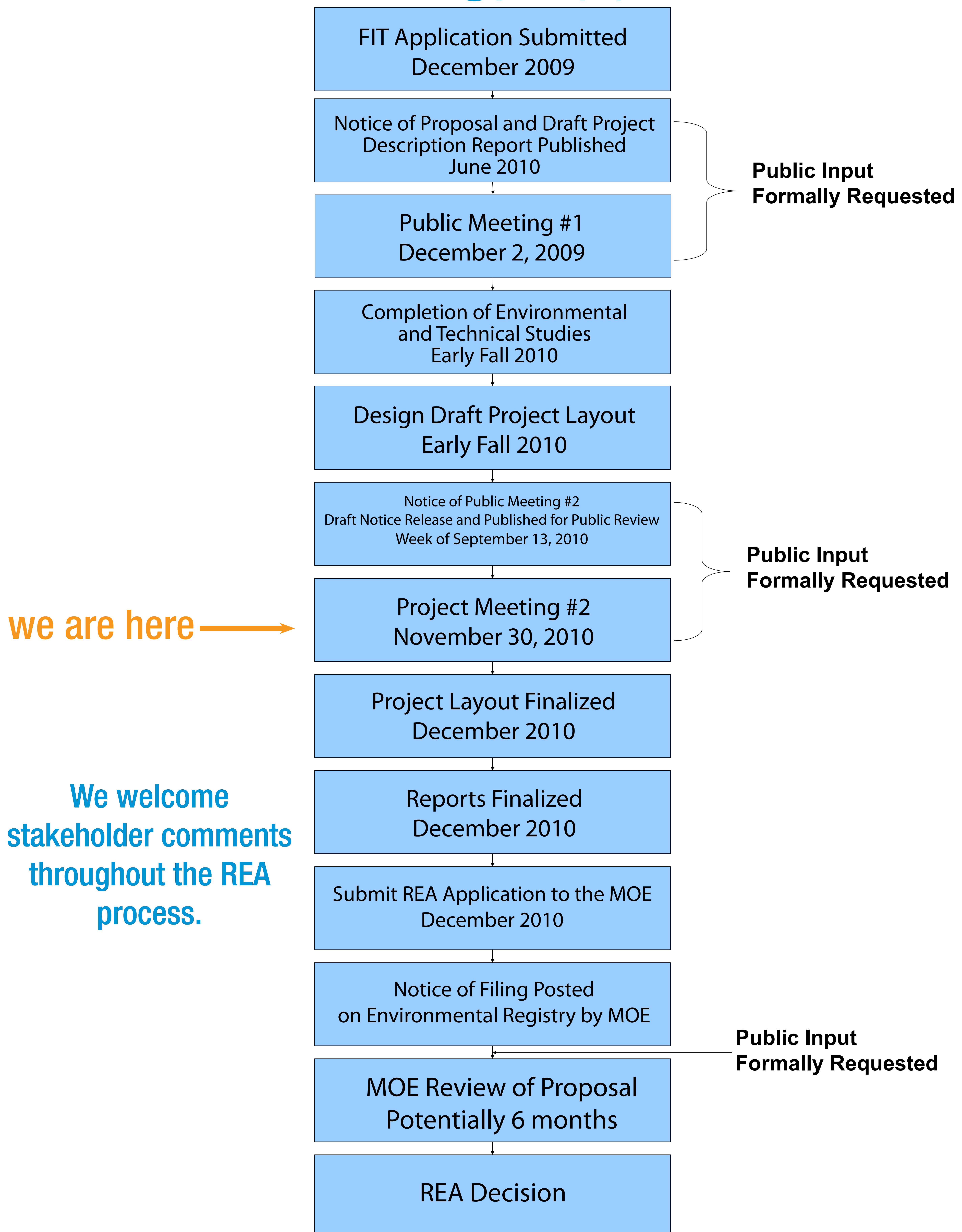

Benefits of Wind Power

Clean and Efficient

- » minimal greenhouse gas emissions - fully offset after six months of operation
- » efficient and reliable
- » complements agricultural operations

The Project: Conestogo

- » Conestogo Wind Energy Centre project is proposed for private lands in Wellington County and is generally bounded in the north by Highway 6, in the east by Sideroad 18, in the south by Fourteenth Line and in the west by Sideroad 16, as shown in the study area map.
- » project categorized as a Class 4 wind facility and has a nameplate capacity of up to 22.9-megawatts. This is the equivalent of enough energy to power 6,600 homes.
- » project infrastructure will include:
 - nine 2.3-megawatt wind turbines and one 2.22-megawatt turbine
 - turbine access roads
 - underground and overhead electrical collector lines
 - transformer substation
 - local storefront office

Wind Turbines and Human Health

- » There is nothing unique about the sounds and vibrations emitted by wind turbines
- » Vibrations produced by wind turbines do not pose a health risk
- » Wind turbines do not pose a risk of hearing loss
- » Sub-audible, low frequency sound and infrasound from wind turbines do not present a risk to human health

NextEra Energy designs its wind farms in accordance with the provincial requirements. We use only the state-of-the-art technologies and construction techniques in building our world-class facilities.

Each one of our facilities meet and adhere to international, national, provincial and all local safety standards. ANSI standards and the United Kingdom's DEFRA standards have been met.

It is important to note, the turbines we use feature "quietness warranties", assuring that sound levels will not exceed certain pre-determined levels and our wind farms are designed accordingly. The level of sound and types of sound reaching neighbors must be determined on a case-by-case basis, depending upon the type of turbine involved, its characteristics, and how far a turbine is separated from a neighboring residence.

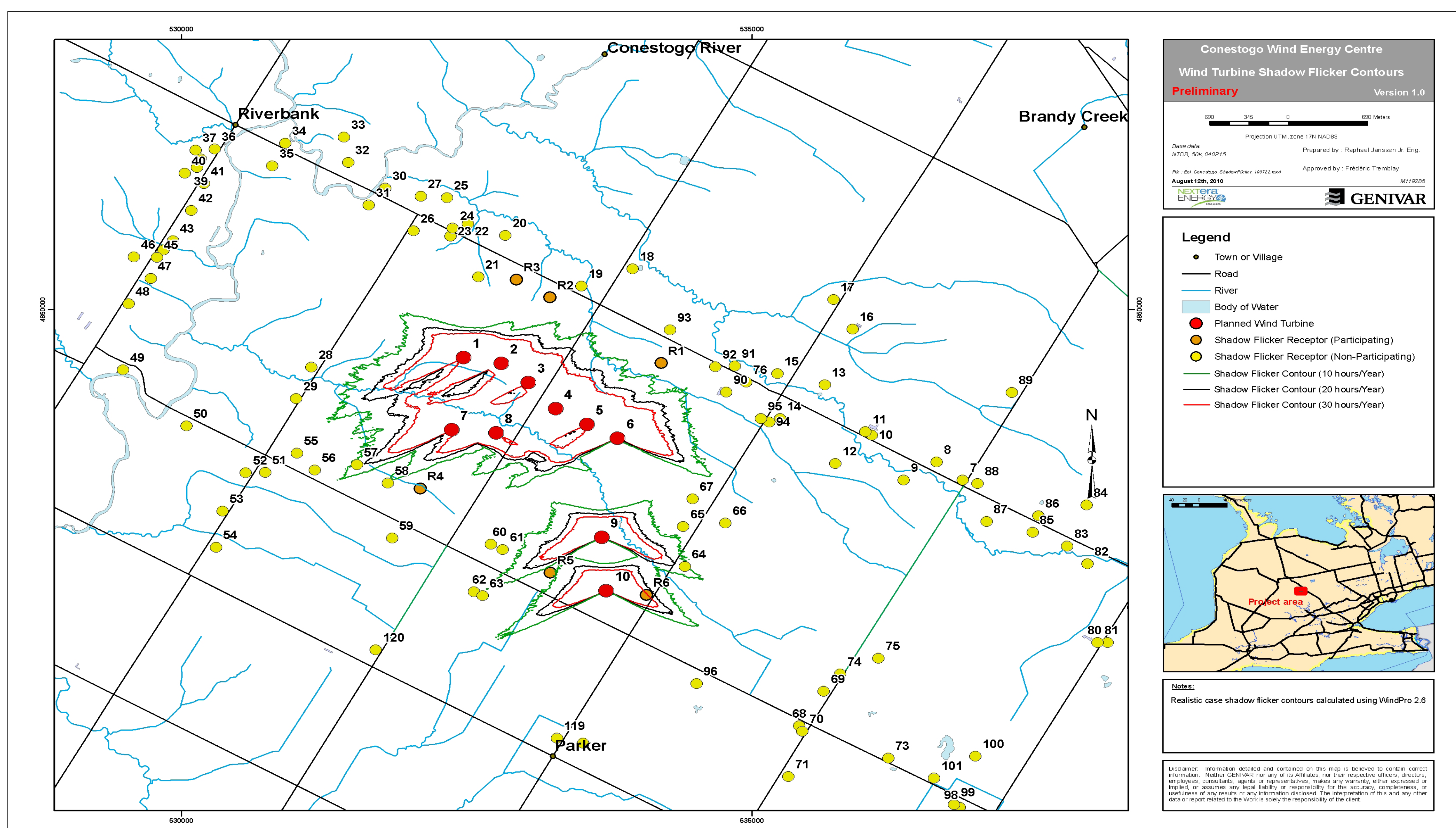
We recognize that there have been many studies based on wind turbines. However, studies from other countries or other wind farms cannot be fairly applied to our wind turbines when analyzing health concerns or establishing set backs. These studies largely focus on larger or different model types, or older designs of wind turbines (with the blades leeward of the nacelle), instead of the newer design type turbines, or the specific models and sizes used by NextEra Energy Resources or its subsidiaries. Only a fair comparison of the same turbine types and identical set backs or arrays are appropriate.

Shadow Flicker

- » Caused by bright sunlight shining through the turbine blades
- » Usually only a problem when the sun is low on the horizon and a window is within the shadow path
- » Amount of shadow flicker depends on weather conditions and the time of year
- » The Shadow Flicker Model assumes worst case and treats all houses as greenhouses (i.e. entire structure made of glass) and does not account for natural barriers such as trees
- » The maximum real-case shadow flicker for a non-participating receptor is up to 13.8 hours per year
- » If needed, can be mitigated in various ways including, but not limited to, planting of trees and adding shades to windows

Aboriginal Engagement

- » Ontario Regulation 359/09 has specific requirements for Aboriginal consultation
- » Ontario Power Authority's Feed in Tariff program reinforces the importance of Aboriginal consultation
- » Canada's Constitution Act, 1982, recognizes the rights of Aboriginal peoples (First Nation, Inuit and Métis)
- » Project proponents are delegated the "procedural aspects" of Aboriginal consultation
- » Aboriginal consultation may include environmental, archaeological, cultural and spiritual issues
- » NextEra Energy Canada is working collaboratively with Aboriginal communities and leadership to:
 - offer meaningful information about its projects
 - seek information that helps ensure good planning to avoid or minimize impacts
 - openly discuss issues, interests and concerns
 - seek workable and mutually acceptable solutions
 - foster relationships of mutual respect

Land Use

» majority of lands in the Project Study Area are agricultural

Agricultural land use and wind turbines work well together:

- turbines and access roads use very little space
- a single turbine, together with its access road, will take up on average only 1.0 – 1.5% of a typical 40 hectare farm parcel
- open space provides optimal wind
- turbines are generally located at the rear of properties due to setback requirements (property lines, buildings, natural heritage features, etc.)
- access roads typically improve access to rear portions of properties and fields



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Archaeology and Heritage



- » archaeological assessment must be conducted if project may have an effect on archaeological artifacts
- » at least two stages of archaeological resource assessments are required for the proposed project

Stage 1 Archaeological Assessment:

- » provides a description and evaluation of all features with archaeological potential in Project Study Area
- » evaluation is based on information gathered about the study area's geography, history, current land use, and any previous archaeological research within the area
- » recommends whether further studies (i.e. a Stage 2 Archaeological Assessment) are required

Stage 2 Archaeological Assessment:

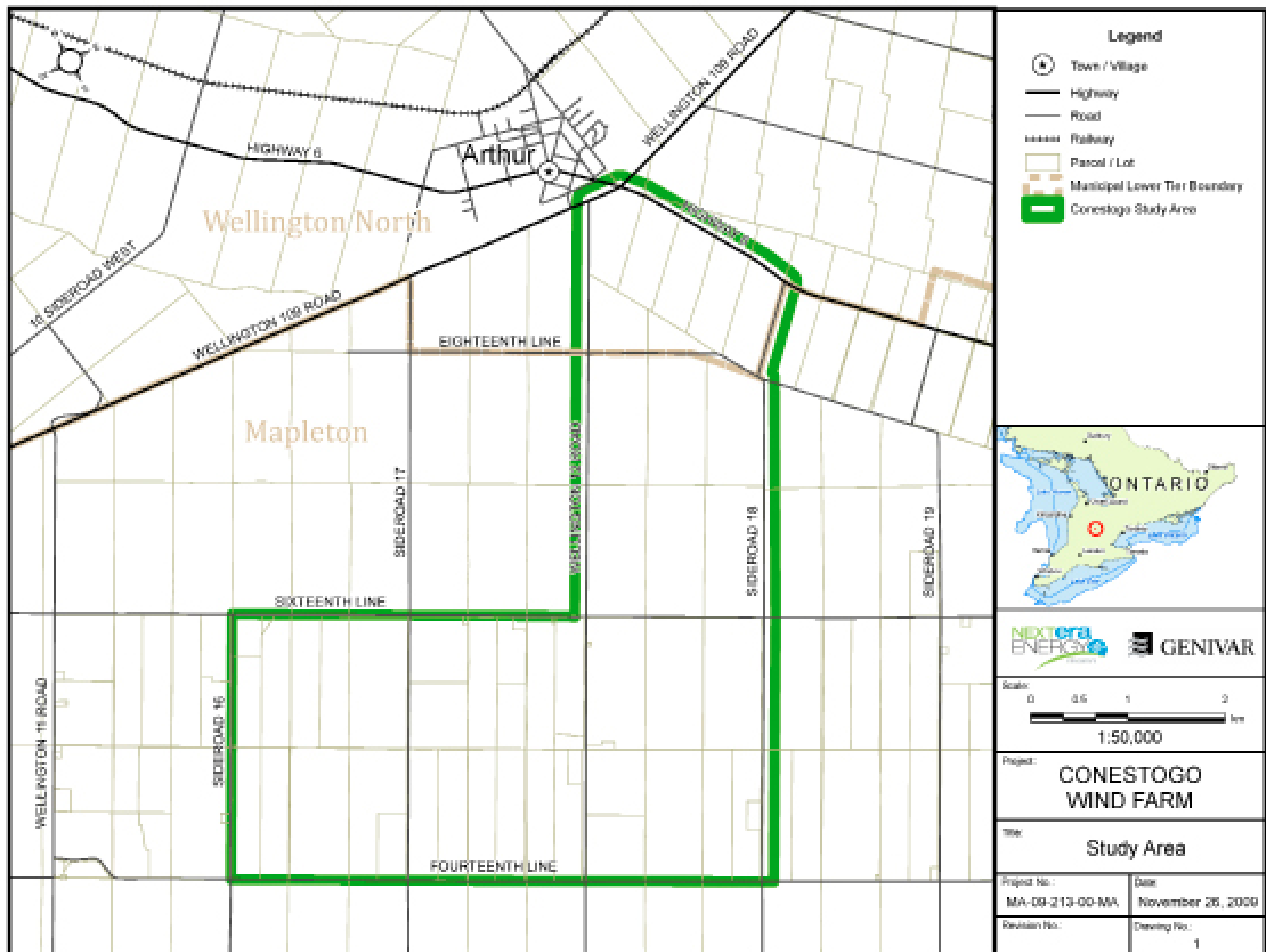
- » provides an inventory of all archaeological sites present in the study area by surveying the proposed locations of project infrastructure
- » If archaeological resources are recovered within the areas surveyed, additional fieldwork may be required by the Ministry of Culture as part of a follow-up Stage 3 or Stage 4 archaeological assessment

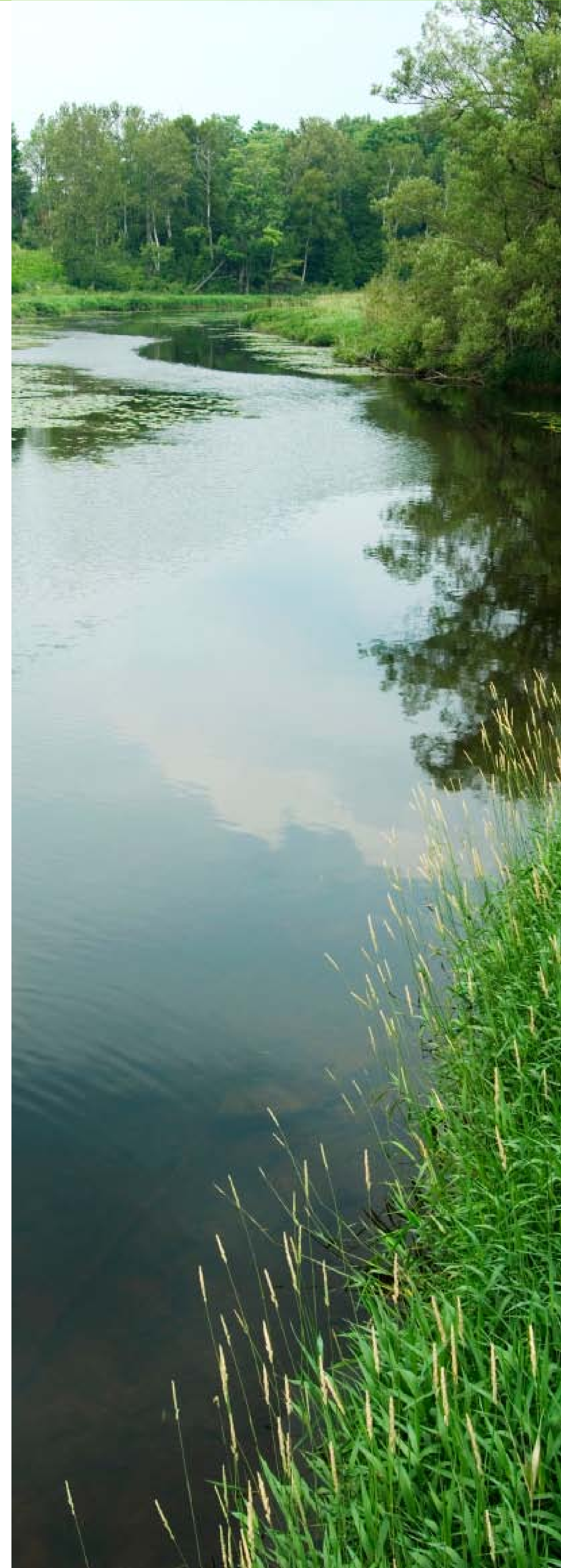


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Natural Heritage: Water

- » aquatic features within 300 metres of proposed turbines, access roads or underground cables have been assessed for potential effects
- » all watercourses in the Project Study Area have been mapped using Ontario Base Mapping and refined based on field surveys
- » aquatic field work confirmed the mapped drainage features and the proposed watercourse crossings and locations of other proposed infrastructure in proximity to watercourses
- » design of access road watercourse crossings will ensure no disruption of flow to downstream areas and no barriers to fish passage
- » will obtain all applicable permits from the appropriate approval agencies (Grand River Conservation Authority)



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Natural Heritage: Birds

- » avian (bird) studies are required as part of the Renewable Energy Approval process
- » the study protocol met the requirements of the Canadian Wildlife Service's "Wind Turbines and Birds: A Guidance Document for Environmental Assessment" and Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources' "Bats and Bird Habitats: Guidelines for Wind Power Projects"
- » with the work plan approved, the study team set out to determine the baseline conditions so the potential effects could be evaluated
- » wintering raptor surveys were completed in January and February 2007
- » spring migrant waterfowl surveys were completed in March 2007
- » breeding bird surveys within the original study area were carried out in June 2007
- » as the location of the wind energy centre narrowed down, additional breeding surveys were completed, June 2009 and June 2010

Key questions addressed by the bird studies:

- What species were found and in what numbers?
- Were there significant concentrations of any species?
- Were there any Species at Risk?
- Were there key habitat features that concentrated birds of concern?

Conclusion: The surveys show that the overall site sensitivity is low -- there were no significant concentrations of birds of concern and no Species at Risk in the current project location

Natural Heritage: Bats

Bat monitoring took place during the summer of 2010 during peak periods of non-migratory bat activity.

Study steps:

- identify natural features that could be significant bat habitat
 - through-the-night acoustic monitoring and evening visual surveys
- » bat monitoring has been completed in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources' "Bats and Bat Habitats: Draft Guidelines for Wind Power Projects (March 2010)" and in conjunction with Natural Heritage Assessment requirements of the Renewable Energy Approvals process
- » Ministry of Natural Resources is also consulted during the development of the bat monitoring protocol for each wind energy centre
- » Acoustic monitoring undertaken in late summer of 2007 and 2010
- » Areas of high bat activity were found in wooded habitats considerable distances from proposed turbine locations

Conclusion: Project not expected to have a significant impact on bat populations or associated habitats

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Noise Studies

Infrasound

Infrasound associated with modern wind turbines is not a source which will result in noise levels that are audible or which may be injurious to the health of a wind farm neighbour.

Low-frequency sound

- » the only turbines that have exhibited low-frequency sound, at any level of concern, were turbines that have their blades located behind the nacelle
- » NextEra Energy Canada will not use this type of turbine
- » testing has confirmed that the turbines we use do not generate any low-frequency sound at levels that could cause harmful health effects

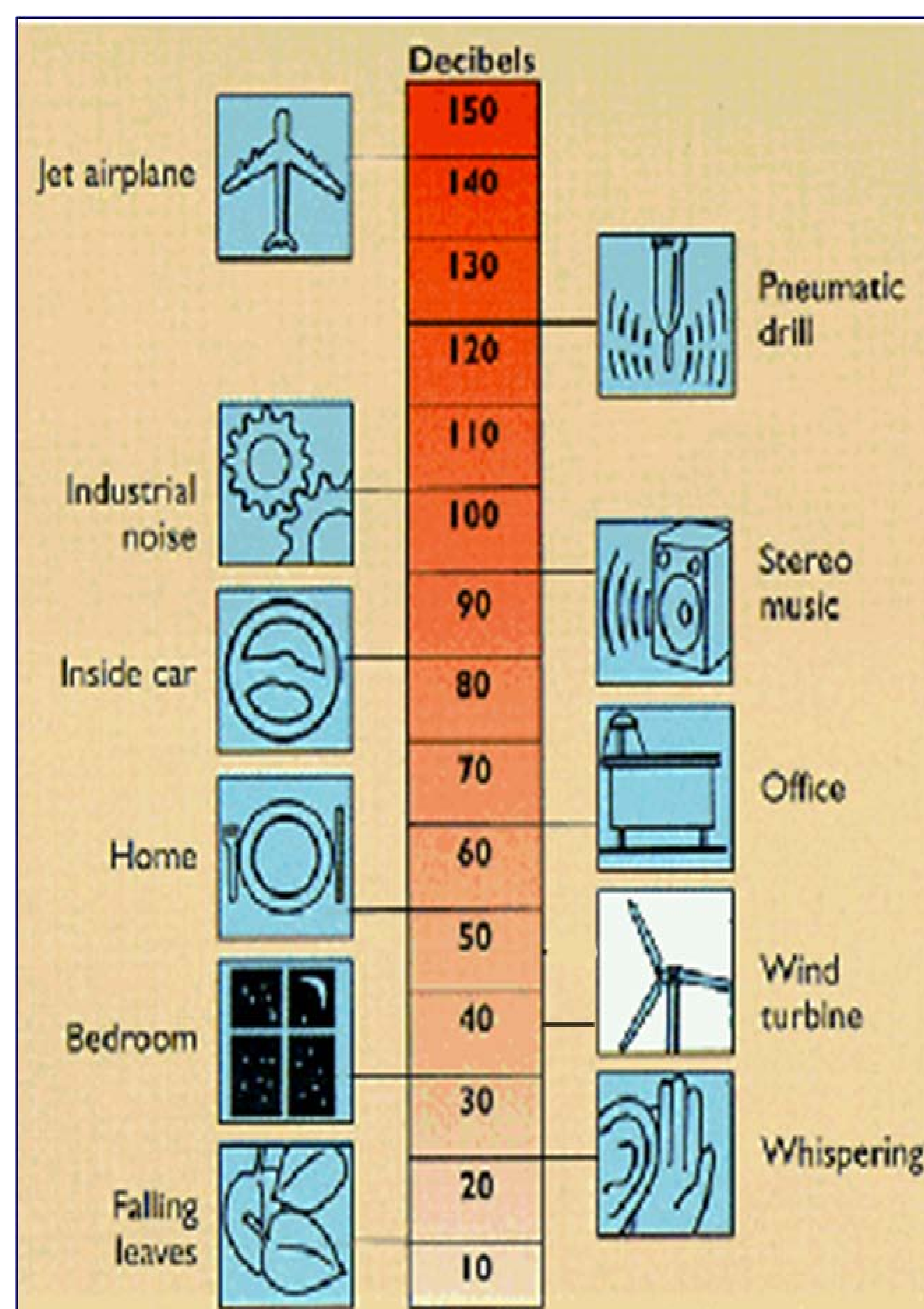
Comparing Sound Levels

Turbines are quiet enough that people can have a normal conversation at the foot of an operating turbine.

The sound of a car passing by 100 m away at 65 km/h is about 55 dB, and the sound of a library is 35-37 dB.

Turbines would be set back from non-participating dwellings at least 550 metres

A detailed sound analysis has been conducted.

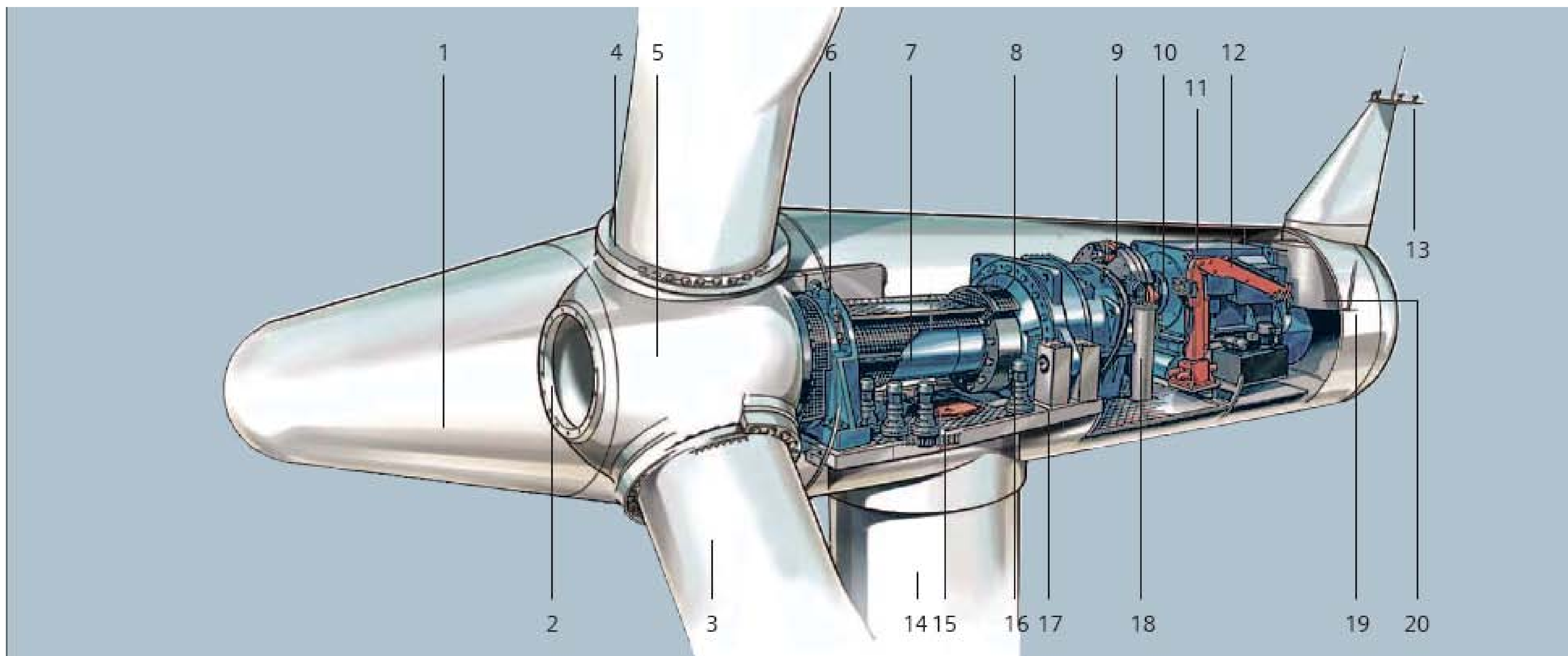

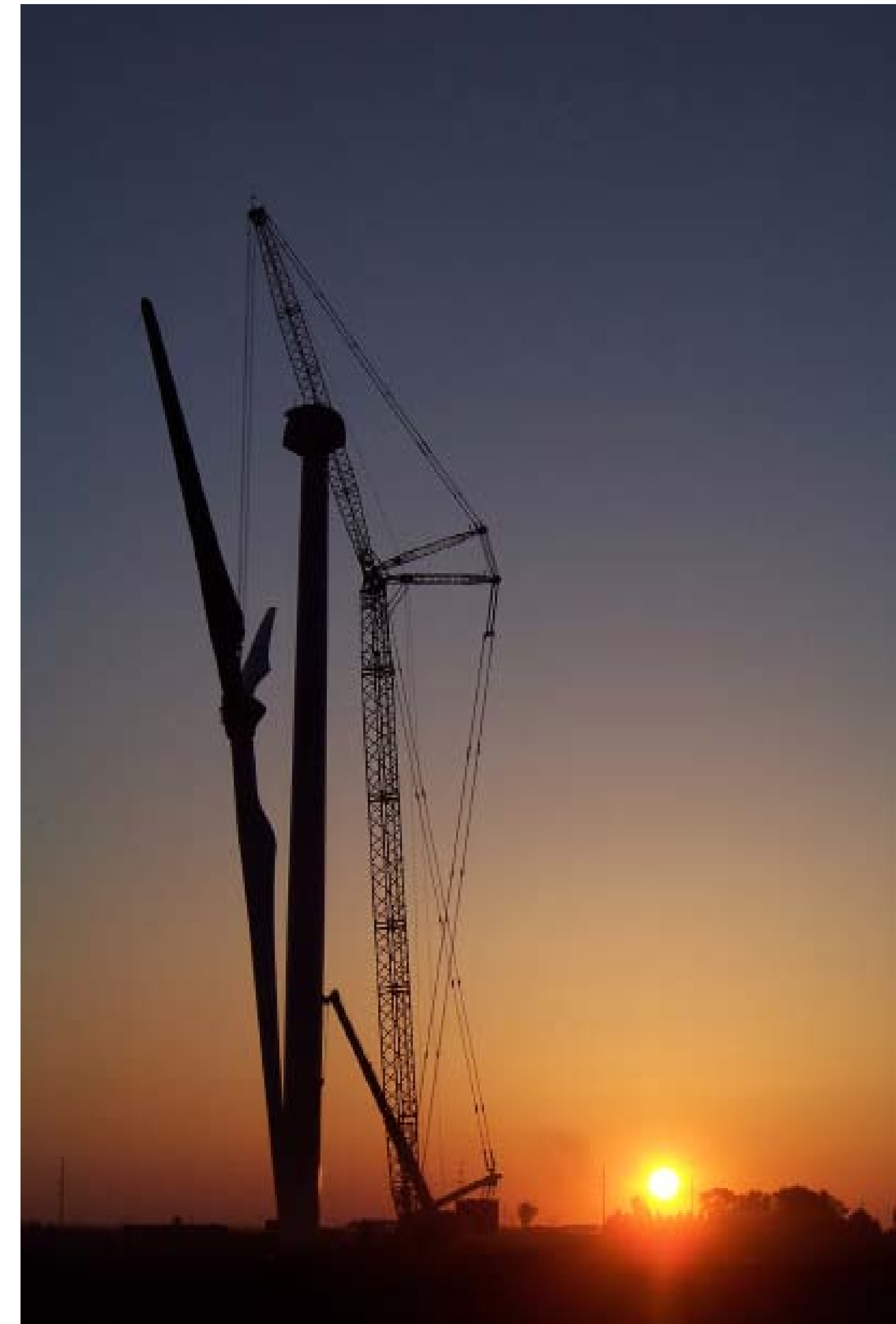
Construction Plan

Turbine siting and surveys

- » site preparation will include final turbine siting and surveys
- » during these surveys, boundaries of turbines sites will be staked and existing buried infrastructure will be located and marked

Access roads

- » Municipal and Provincial roads will be used for transportation of equipment to the construction sites
- » minor modifications may be required to some of the existing roads (e.g., widening the turning radius) for equipment transportation
- » any road damage will be repaired
- » the disturbed area will have the topsoil replaced from stockpiled material and will be reseeded in consultation with the landowner
- » no permanent paved roads will need to be constructed for the turbines
- » equipment will be delivered by truck and trailer as needed throughout the construction phase and stored at temporary laydown sites surrounding each turbine

Construction Plan

Electrical Collector System:

- » this system consists of a mixture of underground cables, overhead lines, pad mounted transformers and a substation
- » underground cables will be used on private property. Above ground cables, using existing poles, wherever possible, will run along road right-of-ways
- » ploughing and trenching will be used to install the underground cables
- » cabling will be buried to a depth of 1 metre and will not interfere with normal agricultural practices. Maps of cable locations will be provided to the landowners

Wind Turbines:

- » foundations are dug and poured with concrete reinforced with steel rebar to provide strength
- » each foundation will require an excavation of approximately 20 metres by 20 metres and 3 metres deep
- » only the tower base portion of the foundation will be left above ground
- » the turbine is then anchored to the foundation by large bolts set in concrete
- » total turbine assembly and installation will typically require 4 - 5 days per site
- » following commissioning, the surrounding area will be returned to its original state

Storefront Office

- » an offsite office will be leased and staffed with full time personnel. It will be used to monitor the day-to-day operations of the wind farm and to support maintenance efforts.

Decommissioning Plan

- » project is expected to be operational for 25+ years
- » the plan describes how turbines and other project components are removed and land is restored
- » repair, refurbishment and replacement of turbines is an ongoing reality of preventative maintenance
- » it may be determined that the project is still viable and the turbines may be refurbished for continued use

Components to be removed:

- turbines
 - overhead lines and poles
 - substation transformer
- » the top one metre of turbine foundations will be removed and replaced with clean and stockpiled with topsoil
 - » areas will be reseeded where appropriate
 - » access road removal will be dependent on the requirements of the landowner

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Stray Voltage

NextEra Energy Canada will use Industry Best Practices in the design of the project to minimize the chance of increased risk of stray voltage to consumers and ensure our projects are built and maintained within acceptable levels as prescribed by the local safety code.

Most cases of “stray voltage” occur when there is either:

- Improper grounding of on-site equipment (in which case it is an issue with on-site wiring) or;
- A change in current patterns on the distribution line, from generation or load, that exposes a preexisting condition (in which case it is an issue with the distribution utility, not with the generator or load)
- The turbines are therefore not the root of the problem, but if they are visible they may be mistaken as the reason that the problem occurs
- All types of generation (wind generation using wind turbines included) must fully comply with utility requirements to ensure that the electricity they supply is compliant with grid standards

How we address these concerns:

- Requires on-site inspection for grounding problems, or examination of power quality issues with distribution utility



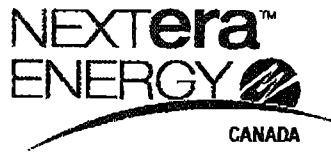
