Appendix C. Glossary of Terms

Non-Negligible Shadow flicker Source or equivalently Significant Shadow flicker Source	A shadow flicker emission source which is determined to have a significant influence on the resultant shadow flicker exposures at a shadow flicker sensitive receptor. This is typically determined from a combination of site observations, measurements and available sound pressure or power data. Acoustical shielding effects or distance attenuation are often used as justification for excluding sources from this category.
Point of Reception or Shadow flicker Sensitive Receptor	Locations were excessive shadow flicker may disrupt the lives or activities of occupants/residents or in general were excessive shadow flicker would interfere with the intended use of the location under consideration.
